## SUPPLIES:

$1 \mathrm{~g} \mathrm{TOHO} 11^{\circ}$ Aiko beads or Treasure beads (A) TOHO One-G Thread Ring as instructed measures 1/4" wide.

## DIRECTIONS:

Note: Each row is two beads high; keep this in mind when counting rows to size your ring. When passing through a row's column, always pass through two beads.

1. On 5' of thread, add four A; pass through all four beads again and arrange them into two columns that are two-beads high, leaving a 4" tail.
2. Add two A; pass down through the second column of this row and up through the two $A$ just added.
3. Add four A; slide the beads down to meet the previous row, then pass through all four beads just added again. Arrange them into two columns that are two-beads high and pass down through the third column of the first row.
4. Pass up through the second column of the first row and the first column of the second row. Pass down through the second column of the second row.
5. Add two A; pass down through the second column of the second row and up through the two $A$ just added.

Repeat Steps 3-5 for the desired length, following the box below.

| Ring Sizing Guide |
| :--- |
| 14 Rows $=$ Size 6.5 |
| 15 Rows $=$ Size 7 |
| 16 Rows $=$ Size 7.5 |
| 17 Rows $=$ Size 8 |
| 18 Rows $=$ Size 8.5 |
| 19 Rows $=$ Size 9 |
| 20 Rows $=$ Size 9.5 |

6. To close the ring, pass up through the second column of the first row. Pass down through the first column of the first row and the third column of the final row. Pass up through the second column of the final row and the first column of the first row. Repeat the thread path around the entire ring to secure tension and add stability. Tie off both threads.
